With the wet Spring we have experienced the easement grasses have grown extra, tall, it won't be long before they start to dry. Weeds/dry grasses in street easement will not be mowed by the county ,reports the work order manager from the Public Service department. In the case of a fire, smoke caused by these dry grasses could hinder both residents evacuation and timely access by emergency crews. The fire mitigation committee would like to encourage all residents to mow the dried grasses/weeds road side of their property. - ✓ Pine needles (must be removed from bags)
- ✓ Construction materials (no nails or wire)
- ✓ Junipers

What is NOT acceptable:

- ✓ NO trash, weeds, or yucca
- ✓ NO nails or wire
- ✓ NO root wads, dirt or rocks
- ✓ NO grass clippings or bags of leaves
