It took six hours for the crew with help from 14 lot owners to remove 59,050 pounds of vegetation from Arrowwood III. Thanks for all the hard work and help in keeping our fire dangers down.

AIA is a nationally Firewise-recognized community. This means as a community we outlined areas that needed fire mitigation and formed a plan to tackle this danger. As we are all aware, our main activity are the bi-annual chipping days.
